White Flower Appeal: The annual collection for the Society for the Protection of the Unborn Child (SPUC) takes place this weekend at St Luke's. SPUC is currently campaigning to stop the decriminalisation of abortion. There are political moves afoot to largely take abortion outside the law by relaxing many of the current legal restrictions, the most dangerous threat to unborn children and their mothers in decades. This is what SPUC is fighting against. Postcards will be available to send to the Prime Minister (via SPUC) to say "Please do not give parliamentary time to decriminalising abortion". So we have the opportunity to support the work of SPUC both financially and by personal action.

Marriage: The start of a new year is a good time to remind any couples who are thinking of getting married that they must give at least six months' notice to the priest. This allows time for preparation to be undertaken and for all necessary paperwork to be completed. Each year, on a Saturday close to St Valentine's Day, Bishop John holds a special service at the Cathedral for engaged couples - a Liturgy of Blessing. This year's celebration will be at 3pm on Saturday 9 February. Please pray for all engaged couples as they prepare for their wedding day and their married life.
