### Rosary during the Month of October for the Church:

As mentioned at last week's Masses Pope Francis has invited us all to join him in praying a daily rosary during this month of October, traditionally devoted to Our Lady, with the special intention of praying for the Church's ongoing fight against evil. He asks that we add to our rosary two traditional prayers, the "Sub Tuum Praesidium" (Under your protection) and the prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel. The words of those two prayers are provided below:

**Sub Tuum Praesidium:** We fly to thy patronage, O Holy Mother of God; despise not our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen.

**Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel** Saint Michael, the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who wander through the world seeking the ruin of souls.
