Mass of Remembrance: On Saturday 10 November there will be a Mass for the Holy Souls at 12noon at Ss Peter and Paul. Everyone (from both parishes) is invited to come and pray for deceased family and friends. There is a list at the back of church for names of those we wish to be remembered and this list will be taken up in the offertory procession at the Mass. If you would like your loved one's name to be read out, please arrive at church early. A memorial candle will also be made available for those who wish to have names read out. Lunch will be available after the Mass.

Volunteers: At the parish meeting in September, we talked about setting up various groups to look after different aspects of parish life. The Parish Leadership Team has considered this further and would like to start with two essentials - a Parish Finance Committee and a Communications Group. The Finance Committee is a requirement for all parishes and there is a diocesan document outlining its constitution - a small number of members with financial, legal or management backgrounds to assist the parish priest in the oversight of parish assets. The the Communications Group could have a wider membership of people with experience of media or social media and perhaps IT expertise. Concert on Remembrance Sunday St Luke's Church – 2pm

Honour choir was formed for an event by Quays Culture in 2014 to commemorate the outbreak of World War One which involved hundreds of local people from all walks of life coming together at MediaCityUK in front of a crowd of over 5000 people to perform specially written music.

Following requests from original choir members, Honour Choir was reformed in 2015 and performed in Cornelia Parker's War Room at the Whitworth Art Gallery. Since then, the choir has performed at numerous local and international events including the Salford Commemoration of The Somme, concerts in France and the Menin Gate ceremony in Ypres during the summer of 2018.

Honour Choir takes great pride in their local connections and has developed the spirit of the original event to bring the local and wider community together to explore the heritage of war stories in a way that connects young and old and particularly those who would not usually engage with remembrance events.

The concert at St Luke's is the highlight of the weekend where the centenary of the end of The War will be commemorated. The performance involves songs and spoken word with an emphasis on Salford and Manchester experiences, followed by the Honour Song Cycle, a piece composed specially for the choir by Andrew J Smith.

Entrance to the concert is free and all are welcome.
